PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 4002

Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall conduct a planning study on the establishment by the state of regional inpatient treatment facilities for persons with substance use disorder. The intended population of persons utilizing these facilities may include but is not limited to persons who are required to engage in treatment as part of a criminal sentence or a deflection program, persons who are released from incarceration to participate in a treatment program, persons who are sentenced to a treatment-based alternative incarceration program or persons who are civilly committed for reasons related to a substance use disorder.

"(2) The department shall present the results of the planning study to the committees of the Legislative Assembly related to addiction and community safety, in the manner described in ORS 192.245, by no later than March 1, 2025.".
