Bill Title: Relating to schools.

Government Unit(s) Affected: State Treasurer, Department of Administrative Services, Department of Education, Oregon Health Authority, Bonding

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Behavioral Health and Health Care Committee to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure appropriates \$570,000 General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA)to provide grants to school-based health centers. The measure also appropriates \$1,400,000 General Fund to OHA to provide grants to 10 school districts or education service districts for district planning and technical assistance related to the development of a school-based health service plan. The measure appropriates \$7,850,000 General Fund to OHA to provide grants to improve and increase school-based mental health services. Additionally, the measure authorizes the State Treasurer to issue lottery bonds that produce \$10 million in net proceeds at the request of OHA to be used for building or renovating school-based health centers, required equipment or other uses related to school-based health centers.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
