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15	"(Energy Industry Advisory Committee)
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17	"SECTION 6a. (1) There is created an Energy Industry Advisory Committee consisting
18	of nine members appointed by the Oregon Energy and Climate Board as follows:
19	"(a) Two members who represent electric investor-owned utilities as that term is defined
20	in ORS 469.631;
21	"(b) One member who represents a natural gas investor-owned utility as that term is
22	defined in ORS 469.631;
23	"(c) Two members who represent consumer-owned utilities as that term is defined in
24	ORS 469A.005;
25	"(d) One member who represents the interests of renewable energy developers;
26	"(e) One member who represents the interests of energy efficiency contractors; and
27	"(f) Two at-large members.
28	"(2) The committee shall provide information and recommendations to the board on:
29	"(a) Energy production, distribution and utilization;
30	"(b) Energy portfolio resources and energy infrastructure resiliency;
31	"(c) Energy industry trends related to matters described in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this
32	subsection; and
33	"(d) Proposals by the Oregon Department of Energy and Climate related to planning,
34	policy and technical analysis.
	"(3) Members of the committee shall be appointed to serve for terms of four years each.

1 A vacancy on the committee shall be filled by appointment by the board for the unexpired 2 term.

"(4) The committee shall select from among themselves a chairperson and any other officers with such terms and duties as the committee considers necessary. A majority of the members of the committee constitutes a quorum. The committee shall meet at least two times per year at the call of the chairperson of the board.

"(5) Members of the committee are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for
expenses and shall serve as volunteers on the committee.

9 "(6) The Oregon Department of Energy and Climate shall provide personnel services to 10 assist the committee within the limits of available funds.".

"(a) Collaborate to identify and evaluate existing programs, policies, projects and activities in order to make recommendations to the Oregon Energy and Climate Board and the Legislative Assembly on ways to coordinate state policies, programs, projects and activities related to energy and climate, with a focus on better coordination of policies or programs so as to increase the effectiveness of efforts to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in Oregon while achieving the mission and purpose of each agency represented on the committee; and

23 "(b) Develop recommendations and strategies for:

24 "(A) State actions that may be taken to help mitigate and adapt to the impacts of climate 25 change; and

26 "(B) The utilization and development of resources for funding state programs, projects and activities related to mitigating and adapting to the impacts of climate change.".

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
