78th OREGON LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY--2015 Regular Session

House Bill 2081

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Revenue)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Specifies ballot title for House Joint Resolution 12 (2015). Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a ballot title; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Pursuant to ORS 250.075 and notwithstanding ORS 250.035, the ballot title 5 for House Joint Resolution 12 (2015), if House Joint Resolution 12 (2015) is referred to the 6 people by the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly in regular session, shall be:

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9 AMENDS CONSTITUTION: PROVIDES THAT ASSESSED VALUE AND MAXIMUM AS10 SESSED VALUE SHALL EQUAL REAL MARKET VALUE FOR FIRST PROPERTY TAX
11 YEAR AFTER SALE OR TRANSFER OF PROPERTY.

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RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "Yes" vote provides that assessed value and maximum assessed value shall be equal to real market value for first property tax year after sale or transfer of property. Current law for determining assessed value and maximum assessed value is retained for subsequent property tax years.

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18 RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "No" vote retains current law, which does not redetermine as-19 sessed value or maximum assessed value of property after sale or transfer.

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SUMMARY: This measure requires that assessed value and maximum assessed value shall equal the real market value of property for the first property tax year after a sale or transfer, as defined by law, of the property.

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26	<u>SECTION 2.</u> The ballot title in section 1 of this 2015 Act shall be printed in the voters $\frac{1}{2}$
27	pamphlet and on the ballot.

28 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 29 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 30 on its passage.
