9	under section 2 [of this 2019 Act], chapter 527, Oregon Laws 2019, on [January 2, 2022] the date
10	specified in subsection (1) of this section, after reversion of unspent lottery allocations to the
11	Veterans' Service Fund established under ORS 406.140, shall be transferred to the Veterans' Edu-
12	cational Aid Account established under ORS 408.090.
13	SECTION 2. Section 8, chapter 527, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to read:
