House Bill 2321

Sponsored by Representative SALINAS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to convene advisory committee to study adequacy of personal protective equipment provided to health care workers to protect against SARS-CoV-2 and to report findings to interim committee of Legislative Assembly.

Sunsets January 2, 2023.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to health care workers; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall convene an advisory committee con-5 sisting of representatives of health care workers and employers of health care workers. The

6 advisory committee shall discuss and research whether health care workers are provided

7 with an amount of and the type of personal protective equipment adequate to protect the

8 health care workers from the disease caused by the severe acute respiratory syndrome

9 coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2).

(2) The authority shall report the findings of the advisory committee to an interim
committee of the Legislative Assembly related to health care, in the manner provided in ORS
192.245, no later than December 15, 2021.

13 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.

14 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 15 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect 16 on its passage.
