## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2322

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "goals;" delete the rest of the line and line 3 and in-
2	sert "and declaring an emergency.".
- 3	Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall update the
5	scope, content and name of the statewide land use planning goal related to energy conser-
6	vation to include policies and direction regarding the development of renewable energy
7	projects consistent with subsections (2) and (3) of this section and, as appropriate, shall
8	consider changes to any other related statewide land use planning goals.
9	"(2) The update to statewide land use planning goals under this section shall:
10	"(a) Be completed on or before December 30, 2021.
11	"(b) Identify adequate and appropriate amounts and types of urban and rural lands to
12	support renewable energy to be developed in the State of Oregon, inside and outside of urban
13	growth boundaries, consistent with the objectives of Oregon's renewable portfolio standards
14	and Oregon's statutory greenhouse gas emissions reduction goals.
15	"(3) In updating the goals, the commission shall, at a minimum, consider the following:
16	"(a) The Oregon Climate Agenda released by the Governor and dated November 28, 2018;
17	"(b) The energy and land use needs of Oregon's communities;
18	"(c) Areas where siting renewable energy projects could be appropriately prioritized over
19	or coexist with other land uses;
20	"(d) The role of efficiency and conservation in meeting energy demand;
21	"(e) The role of community solar projects;
22	"(f) The adequacy and appropriateness of lands within urban growth boundaries;
23	"(g) Protection of agricultural and forest areas;
24	"(h) Preservation of fish and wildlife habitat;
25	"(i) Protection of open spaces and recreational areas;
26	"(j) Location and proximity of infrastructure necessary for renewable energy generation
27	and distribution; and
28	"(k) Other important economic, environmental, social and natural items.
29	"SECTION 2. (1) An advisory committee shall assist the Land Conservation and Devel-
30	opment Commission in the update of statewide land use planning goals under section 1 of this
31	2019 Act.
32	"(2) The advisory committee shall consist of members as follows:
33	"(a) The Director of the Department of Land Conservation and Development shall ap-
34	point:
35	"(A) A member to represent city governments;

1	"(B) A member to represent county governments;
<b>2</b>	"(C) A member to represent renewable energy development businesses;
3	"(D) A member to represent farming or ranching businesses;
4	"(E) A member to represent forestry businesses;
5	"(F) A member to represent environmental interests;
6	"(G) A member to represent electric utility companies;
7	"(H) A member to represent energy conservation communities;
8	"(I) A member to represent federally recognized tribes; and
9	"(J) Such other members as the director deems appropriate;
10	"(b) The Governor shall appoint a member to represent the office of the Governor;
11	"(c) The Director of Agriculture shall appoint a member to represent the State Depart-
12	ment of Agriculture;
13	"(d) The State Forester shall appoint a member to represent the State Forestry Depart-
14	ment;
15	"(e) The Director of the State Department of Energy shall appoint a member to represent
16	the State Department of Energy;
17	"(f) The Public Utility Commission of Oregon shall appoint a member to represent the
18	commission;
19	"(g) The State Fish and Wildlife Director shall appoint a member to represent the State
20	Department of Fish and Wildlife; and
21	"(h) The Environmental Justice Task Force shall appoint a member to represent envi-
22	ronmental justice issues.
23	"SECTION 3. All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed
24	to assist the Land Conservation and Development Commission and the advisory committee
25	described in section 2 of this 2019 Act in performing actions under sections 1 and 2 of this
26	2019 Act.
27	"SECTION 4. No later than December 31, 2020, the Land Conservation and Development
28	Commission shall provide a report to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative
29	Assembly, in the manner provided under ORS 192.245, on the progress of the commission
30	under sections 1 and 2 of this 2019 Act.
31	"SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
32	priated to the Department of Land Conservation and Development, for the biennium begin-
33	ning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$, for the purpose of
34	administering and implementing sections 1 to 4 of this 2019 Act.
35	" <u>SECTION 6.</u> This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
36	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect
37	July 1, 2019.".
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
