**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates [*\$500,000*] **\$5,000,000** to Higher Education Coordinating Commission to award [*grant to College Possible organization*] **grants to certain organizations.**  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to assistance to low income students to attend a post-secondary institution; and declaring  
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there are appro-**  
6 **propriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July**  
7 **1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the following amounts:**

8 (1) **\$1,000,000 for the Access to Student Assistance Programs in Reach of Everyone (AS-**  
9 **PIRE) established under ORS 348.500;**

10 (2) **\$1,000,000 for the purpose of awarding a grant to the College Possible organization;**

11 (3) **\$1,000,000 for the purpose of awarding a grant to the Advancement Via Individual**  
12 **Determination (AVID) organization;**

13 (4) **\$1,000,000 for the purpose of awarding a grant to the BUILD EXITO program at**  
14 **Portland State University; and**

15 (5) **\$1,000,000 for the purpose of awarding a grant to the Oregon TRIO Association.**

16 **SECTION 2. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**  
18 **on July 1, 2021.**
