House Bill 2473

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes grant program to facilitate installation of self-service dispensing devices at motor vehicle fuel dispensaries in low-population counties. Appropriates moneys to fund grant program for 2017-2019 biennium.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to motor vehicle fuel dispensaries.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The State Fire Marshal may issue grants to dispensaries described in 5 ORS 480.341 to facilitate the installation of self-service dispensing devices. Grants may be for 6 all or part of the installation costs of the devices, but may not total more than 7 \$______ for each dispensary.

8 (2) The State Fire Marshal may adopt rules the State Fire Marshal deems reasonable for 9 the administration and enforcement of the grant program described in subsection (1) of this 10 section.

11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-12 ated to the Department of State Police, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the 13 General Fund, the amount of \$_____, which may be expended by the State Fire Marshal to

14 carry out the grant program described in section 1 of this 2017 Act.
