House Bill 2484

Sponsored by Representative BENTZ (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Defers annual minimum wage increases in Baker and Malheur Counties by two years. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a deferred minimum wage increase for certain counties that border Idaho; and declaring

an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 653.

6 SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 653.025, an employer located in Baker County or

Malheur County may defer by two years each annual minimum wage rate otherwise required
under ORS 653.025 (3)(b) to (g).

9 (2) After June 30, 2025, an employer described in subsection (1) of this section may not

employ or agree to employ any employee at wages computed at a rate lower than the rate
 provided in ORS 653.025 (3)(h).

12 SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is repealed on July 1, 2025.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
 on its passage.
