SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs Department of Transportation to waive driving privilege reinstatement fee if driving privileges were suspended for [failing to pay fine] certain traffic offenses. Sunsets January 2, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

2 Relating to reinstating driving privileges; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle 5 Code.

SECTION 2. (1) In addition to the reasons for which the Department of Transportation 6 may waive reinstatement fees under ORS 809.380 (6), the department shall waive the rein-7 statement fee if a driving privilege suspension occurred pursuant to any of the following or 8 a combination of the following: 9 (a) ORS 809.210 (2019 Edition); 10 11 (b) ORS 809.220; or (c) ORS 809.415 (3) for failure to provide new proof of compliance for future responsibility 12 filings when requested by the department. 13

14 (2) Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to a person whose driving privileges are

also concurrently suspended under provisions not listed in subsection (1) of this section.

16 SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.

17 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021
18 regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
