

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2579

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “offenders” insert a period and delete the rest of the
2 line.

3 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 **“(a) ‘Reentry support and services’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 423.110.**

6 **“(b) ‘Sentence’ includes a period of incarceration, any period of transitional leave, work
7 release or program of conditional or supervised release authorized by law and any period of
8 post-prison supervision.**

9 **“(c) ‘Youth correction facility’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 420.005.**

10 **“(2) The Oregon Youth Authority may provide reentry support and services for offenders
11 who, having been committed to the legal and physical custody of the Department of Cor-
12 rections and thereafter transferred to the physical custody of the authority under ORS
13 137.124 and 420.011, are released from a youth correction facility:**

14 **“(a) On any form of transitional leave, work release or program of conditional or super-
15 vised release authorized by law; or**

16 **“(b) On post-prison supervision.**

17 **“(3) The authority may provide the reentry support and services to an offender described
18 in subsection (2) of this section until the earlier of the following dates:**

19 **“(a) The date on which the offender attains 25 years of age; or**

20 **“(b) The date on which the offender completes the sentence for the offense for which the
21 offender was transferred to the physical custody of the authority under ORS 137.124 and
22 420.011.**

23 **“(4) The authority, in collaboration with county community corrections agencies and the
24 Department of Corrections, shall adopt rules to carry out the provisions of this section.”.**
