SUMMARY

Directs Water Resources Department to review water measurement data collection, retention, use and reporting and report to committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to water on or before September 15, 2022.

Sunsets January 2, 2023.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Water Resources Department shall review:
5	(a) Where and how water measurements are collected and retained;
6	(b) Who has access to collected data about water measurements;
7	(c) How water measurement data is used;
8	(d) Who pays for the collection of water measurement data;
9	(e) How often water measurement data is collected;
10	(f) Which persons are subject to water measurement and reporting requirements; and
11	(g) Which, if any, persons that are required to measure water and report water measure
12	urements are not doing so.
13	(2) The department shall present the review in a report to a committee or interim com
14	mittee of the Legislative Assembly related to water, in the manner provided under ORS

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
