HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2666

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 31 and insert:

2	"SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, 'mandatory student-initiated fee' means a fee
3	that:
4	"(a) Is initiated by the recognized student government of the community college;
5	"(b) Students are required to pay in addition to tuition fees;
6	"(c) Is collected by the board of the community college; and
7	"(d) Is allocated by the recognized student government of the community college.
8	"(2) The board for each community college shall collect mandatory student-initiated fees
9	upon the request of the recognized student government of the community college to the
10	president of the community college under a process established by the recognized student
11	government in consultation with the board. Mandatory student-initiated fees collected under
12	this section must be allocated by the recognized student government.
13	"(3) If the recognized student government makes a request under subsection (2) of this
14	section for a new or increased mandatory student-initiated fee, the board may require a
15	campus referendum in which the student body votes on whether to approve the fee. If a
16	mandatory student-initiated fee is rejected by the student body in a referendum held under
17	this subsection, the recognized student government may not request another mandatory
18	student-initiated fee for the remainder of the academic year.
19	"(4) A request for a mandatory student-initiated fee, use of the fee or decision to modify
20	an existing fee may be refused by the president if the president determines that:
21	"(a) The recognized student government assessed or allocated the mandatory student-
22	initiated fee in violation of applicable local, state or federal law;
23	"(b) The allocation conflicts with a preexisting contractual financial commitment;
24	"(c) The total mandatory student-initiated fees budget would increase by a percentage
25	that is greater than the percentage increase in tuition and other fees approved by the board
26	for the upcoming academic year; or
27	"(d) The fee request is not advantageous to the cultural or physical development of stu-
28	dents.
29	"(5) The recognized student government and the president shall seek to reach agreement
30	on any dispute involving mandatory student-initiated fees, if necessary with the aid of a
31	process established by the board, prior to a decision by the president.
32	"(6) If an agreement is not reached, the decision of the president may be appealed to the
33	board, which will render a final decision prior to the adoption, use or modification of a

mandatory student-initiated fee.".
