Extends sunset for construction or installation of alternative energy devices.

Section 5a, chapter 832, Oregon Laws 2005, as amended by section 35, chapter 843, 4 Oregon Laws 2007, section 12, chapter 913, Oregon Laws 2009, section 16, chapter 83, Oregon Laws $\mathbf{5}$ 2011, and section 67, chapter 730, Oregon Laws 2011, is amended to read: 6 Sec. 5a. (1) A taxpayer may not be allowed a credit under ORS 316.116 if the first tax year for 7 which the credit would otherwise be allowed with respect to an alternative energy device begins 8 on or after January 1, [2018] 2024. 9 (2) A taxpayer may not be allowed a credit under ORS 316.116 if the first tax year for which the 10 11 credit would otherwise be allowed with respect to an alternative fuel vehicle or related equipment begins on or after January 1, 2012. 12
