## House Bill 2702

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires school districts to ensure that students in grade 12 receive instructional program on home ownership. Directs Department of Education to prepare materials to assist school districts in providing program.

- 2 Relating to instructional program on home ownership.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Each school district shall ensure that students in grade 12 receive an instructional program on home ownership. The instructional program must be at least one hour.
  - (2) The Department of Education shall consult with the Real Estate Commission to prepare materials to assist school districts in providing an instructional program on home ownership.
  - (3) An instructional program on home ownership may be provided by a licensed teacher, a person licensed by the Real Estate Commissioner or a representative of a financial institution.
    - SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2021 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2022.
  - (2) Section 1 of this 2021 Act first applies to the 2022-2023 school year.
  - (3) Notwithstanding the operative date set forth in subsection (1) of this section, the Department of Education may take any action before the operative date set forth in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary for school districts to comply with the requirements of section 1 of this 2021 Act.

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
