## House Bill 2758

Sponsored by Representative DOHERTY

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Creates crime of misrepresenting an animal as an assistance animal. Makes violation subject to fine not exceeding \$1,000.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to animals.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
  - (a) "Assistance animal" and "assistance animal trainee" have the meanings given those terms in ORS 659A.143.
    - (b) "Place of public accommodation" has the meaning given that term in ORS 659A.400.
  - (2) A person commits the crime of misrepresenting an animal as an assistance animal if the person:
  - (a) Brings an animal that is not an assistance animal or assistance animal trainee into a place of public accommodation and, in response to an inquiry by an owner or employee of the place of public accommodation, falsely asserts that the animal is an assistance animal or assistance animal trainee; or
  - (b)(A) Affixes to an animal that is not an assistance animal or assistance animal trainee any false information or improper identification vest, tag, license, permit or other device that portrays the animal as an assistance animal or assistance animal trainee; and
    - (B) Brings the animal into a place of public accommodation.
  - (3) Misrepresenting an animal as an assistance animal is an unclassified violation, subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.
