House Bill 2827

Sponsored by Representative WILLIAMS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Bureau of Labor and Industries to study and make recommendations for establishing child care apprenticeship programs to expand child care workforce. Requires bureau to submit report on findings to interim committee of Legislative Assembly by January 1, 2023. Sunsets January 2, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to expansion of child care workforce. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall study and make recommendations for establishing a child care apprenticeship program to expand the child care workforce in this state. (2) The bureau shall submit a report on its findings to an appropriate interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than January 1, 2023.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
