House Bill 2855

Sponsored by Representative EVANS; Senator PATTERSON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Establishes Compliance Division within Oregon Department of Emergency Management to ensure compliance with requirements and regulations relating to moneys received from federal government.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to compliance monitoring; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) There is established the Compliance Division as an administrative divi-4

5 sion of the Oregon Department of Emergency Management. The Director of the Oregon De-

6 partment of Emergency Management shall appoint a compliance officer to lead the division.

7 The compliance officer serves at the pleasure of and at the direction of the director. The

8 director may appoint additional staff to the division as the director deems necessary for the 9 division to carry out its duties.

10 (2) The Compliance Division shall:

11 (a) Ensure that the department is in compliance with requirements and regulations re-

12lating to moneys received from the federal government, including ensuring compliance by

grantees or subgrantees; 13

14 (b) Prepare and maintain documentation related to compliance;

(c) Establish monitoring and reporting requirements as necessary to ensure compliance; 15

16 (d) Identify compliance risks and direct and supervise corrective actions to mitigate such 17 risks; and

18 (e) Serve as liaison between the department and federal officials.

(3) Public bodies, as defined in ORS 174.109, shall promptly provide to the Compliance 19

20 Division any books, records or other documentation that the division determines to be nec-21essary to carry out its duties.

22SECTION 2. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 23 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect 24on its passage.
