House Bill 2880

Prohibits mass transit district from collecting user charges, fees or tolls from disabled veterans for use of mass transit system.

2 Relating to mass transit districts; amending ORS 267.320.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 267.320 is amended to read:

5 267.320. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, to carry out the powers granted by 6 ORS 267.010 to 267.390, [the] **a** district board may by ordinance impose and may collect user charges, 7 fees and tolls from those who are served by or use the transit system and other facilities and ser-

8 vices of the district.

9 (2) [*The*] **A** district [*shall*] **may** not charge a person over 65 years of age a fee of more than 50 10 percent of the regular fee for transportation provided by the district. The maximum fee established 11 by this subsection does not apply on any weekday, Monday through Friday, between the hours of 5 12 a.m. and 9 a.m. or between the hours of 3 p.m. and 7 p.m.

(3)(a) Subject to paragraph (b) of this subsection, a district may not collect user charges,
 fees or tolls from a disabled veteran, as defined in ORS 408.225, for the use of the transit
 system.

(b) A district board may, by ordinance, establish a pass, card or similar device that a
disabled veteran must present to demonstrate proof of eligibility for the benefit conferred
by paragraph (a) of this subsection.
