

# House Bill 2881

Sponsored by Representatives REARDON, PARRISH

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of State Lands, for purpose of identifying land that could be planned and zoned for residential use, to inventory department land, determine whether land is essential, useful or excessive in relation to plans of department, and report results to Legislative Assembly.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to inventory of land owned by the Department of State Lands.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "lot," "parcel" and "tract" have the meanings**  
5 **given those terms in ORS 215.010.**

6 **(2) The Legislative Assembly finds and declares a need to identify land that can be**  
7 **planned and zoned for residential use.**

8 **(3) The Department of State Lands shall conduct an inventory of the real property owned**  
9 **by the department and make findings as to whether each lot, parcel or tract of land is es-**  
10 **sential, useful or excessive in relation to the department's plans for the next \_\_\_\_\_ years.**

11 **(4) The department shall report the inventory to the Legislative Assembly in the manner**  
12 **described in ORS 192.245 on or before October 1, 2016.**
