## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2997

1 Delete lines 4 through 19 of the printed bill and insert:

2 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 3 \$250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for 4 payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-5 nomic Development Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for business, 6 innovation and trade, for the purpose of funding of cooperative efforts by the National Policy 7 Consensus Center of Portland State University and community organizations to:

8 "(1) Provide businesses engaged in western juniper harvesting, or in the manufacturing 9 of products from western juniper, with technical business assistance, market development 10 and supply chain coordination between businesses, other private organizations and govern-11 mental entities; and

12 "(2) Promote liaison efforts between public and private activities and programs within 13 this state for western juniper harvesting and related manufacturing, and public and private 14 activities and programs for wildlife management in order to address ecological or economic 15 interests and concerns.

"SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
July 1, 2015.".
