SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys to [Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development] Higher Education Coordinating Commission to be expended for grant program that distributes moneys to community colleges, or any foundations of community colleges, to increase number of underserved, low-income and first-generation college-bound students who enroll in community college and make progress toward degree or certificate.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1, chapter 51, Oregon Laws 2014, is amended to read:
6	Sec. 1. (1) The Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development and the Higher
7	Education Coordinating Commission shall jointly establish a grant program for the purpose of dis-
8	tributing moneys to community colleges, or any foundations of community colleges, to increase
9	the number of underserved, low-income and first-generation college-bound students who enroll in
10	community college and make progress toward a degree or a certificate.
11	(2) Moneys distributed under subsection (1) of this section may be used by a community
12	college, or a foundation of a community college, for services that are designed to increase stu-
13	dent enrollment, retention and degree and certificate completion, including counseling programs,
14	college initiatives, advising services and assistance in obtaining financial aid.
15	(3) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission may adopt rules necessary for the adminis-
16	tration of this section, including rules that set standards for awarding grants. The standards shall
17	give priority to community colleges, or foundations of community colleges, that have student
18	enrollment, retention and degree and certificate completion programs with demonstrated support
19	from the private sector, the community and local government.
20	SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
21	ated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1,
22	2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3 million, which may be expended for the grant
23	program described in section 1, chapter 51, Oregon Laws 2014.
