SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates crime of domestic terrorism. Punishes by maximum penalty of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to domestic terrorism.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A person commits the crime of domestic terrorism if the person inten-

5 tionally attempts to cause catastrophic harm.

6 (2) Domestic terrorism is a Class B felony.

7 (3) As used in this section, "catastrophic harm" means harm that:

8 (a) Results in extraordinary levels of death, injury, property damage or disruption of daily

9 life; and

10 (b) Severely affects the population, infrastructure, environment, economy or government

11 functioning of this state.
