House Bill 3126

Sponsored by Representative WILDE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs school district to develop and annually review district equity plan. Prescribes requirements of plan.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to district equity plans.

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- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 329.
- 5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Each school district shall develop and annually review a district equity 6 plan as provided by this section.
 - (2) A district equity plan must:
 - (a) Analyze for each school of the school district any educational disparities for students who are:
 - (A) From underserved racial or ethnic populations, as compared to students from other populations in the school;
 - (B) From families in poverty, as compared to students in the school who are not from families in poverty; and
 - (C) Receiving special education and related services, as compared to students in the school who are not receiving special education and related services.
 - (b) Analyze for the school district any educational disparities for students who are:
 - (A) From underserved racial or ethnic populations, as compared to students from other populations in the school district;
 - (B) From families in poverty, as compared to students in the school district who are not from families in poverty; and
 - (C) Receiving special education and related services, as compared to students throughout this state who are not receiving special education and related services.
 - (c) Identify how the school district will remedy any educational disparities identified in the analyses made under paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection.
 - (3) For the purpose of identifying educational disparities, school districts shall compare student groups identified in subsection (2) of this section based on:
 - (a) High school graduation rates, for students in grades 9 through 12; and
 - (b) Results on standardized assessments or other measures of educational attainment approved by the Department of Education for students in kindergarten through grade 9.
 - (4) A district equity plan must attempt to remedy any educational disparities by:
 - (a) Bringing the student groups identified in subsection (2)(a) and (b) of this section

- within 10 percent of the comparable student group for rates or results identified in subsection (3) of this section; and
 - (b) Addressing any other structural factors contributing to educational disparities.
- (5) After conducting an annual review of the district equity plan, a school district must produce a report that includes:
- (a) Recommendations for resources and programs necessary to remedy identified educational disparities;
- (b) Information regarding spending to provide the resources and programs identified in paragraph (a) of this subsection; and
- (c) Any successes or failures in remedying educational disparities identified in previous reports, and an explanation of the causes of the successes or failures.
 - (6) A district equity plan and report prepared under this section must be:
 - (a) Submitted each year to the Department of Education; and
 - (b) Made available at the school district's main office and on the school district's website.
- (7) The State Board of Education shall adopt any rules necessary for the implementation of this section.

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
