

House Bill 3157

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to amend Low-Rise Residential Dwelling Code to require alternative energy collection or generation by December 15, 2020. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to residential alternative energy; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 455.**

5 **SECTION 2. The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall**
6 **require the Low-Rise Residential Dwelling Code to require as a standard of construction that**
7 **dwellings constructed under the code must include one or more appropriate methods of al-**
8 **ternative energy collection or generation.**

9 **SECTION 3. The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall**
10 **take necessary steps to amend the Low-Rise Residential Dwelling Code to conform with the**
11 **requirements of section 2 of this 2019 Act no later than December 15, 2020.**

12 **SECTION 4. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
13 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
