## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure

Directs State Department of Agriculture to advance design of cannabis business certification program. Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to allocate moneys from Marijuana Control and Regulation Fund to department for purposes of cannabis business certification program. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to a cannabis business certification program; and declaring an emergency. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "cannabis" includes hemp and marijuana.

 $\mathbf{5}$ (2) The State Department of Agriculture shall advance the design of standards and iden-

tification of pilot sites for the implementation of a cannabis business certification program. 6

(3) The cannabis business certification program must promote market-based approaches 7

that create incentives for cannabis business operations to use low-carbon cultivation tech-8

niques that use energy and water efficiently. 9

(4) The department may contract with a third-party nonprofit organization that has 10 11 technical expertise in the measurement of and best practices associated with energy and water usage in cannabis businesses. 12

SECTION 2. The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall allocate to the State Depart-13 ment of Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the Marijuana Control 14 and Regulation Fund established under ORS 475B.296, the amount of \$300,000 for the pur-1516 poses described in section 1 of this 2019 Act.

SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 17peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect 18 July 1, 2019. 19
