House Bill 3214

Sponsored by Representatives MCKEOWN, SPRENGER; Representative MALSTROM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Office of Rural Health to conduct study and develop recommendations on whether to allow health care practitioner students who do not attend Oregon Health and Science University to participate in Scholars for a Healthy Oregon Initiative.

Requires office to submit report detailing recommendations by December 1, 2018. Sunsets January 2, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to health care practitioners.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Office of Rural Health shall conduct a study and develop recommendations on whether to allow health care practitioner students who do not attend the Oregon Health and Science University to be eligible to participate in the Scholars for a Healthy Oregon Initiative established in ORS 348.303. The study shall include an analysis on whether expanding access to the initiative in the way proposed by this subsection would be effective in helping to alleviate the lack of health care providers in rural Oregon.
 - (2) The office shall submit a report detailing the recommendations and analysis made under subsection (1) of this section to the interim legislative committees on health care no later than December 1, 2018.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.
