SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Provides that cities and counties may seek reimbursement for construction on arterial highways under certain circumstances.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to highways. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: 4 (a) "Arterial highway" has the meaning given that term in ORS 801.127. 5 (b) "Highway" has the meaning given that term in ORS 801.305. 6 7 (c) "Road authority" has the meaning given that term in ORS 801.445. 8 (2) A city or county that has paid for maintenance or other improvements to an arterial highway for which the city or county is the road authority may submit a written request to the Department of Transportation for reimbursement of up to 20 percent of the costs to 10 maintain or improve the arterial highway. 11 12 (3) Reimbursement under this section shall be paid only after the department receives a 13 written request, made in the form and manner required by the department by rule. (4) The department shall pay the costs of reimbursement from the funds available to the 14 department. 15 (5) This section applies to the portions of an arterial highway that: 16 (a) Are located within one mile of an interstate highway; and 17

(b) Exceed the recommended level of traffic, as determined by the department by rule.
