## House Bill 3294

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Secretary of State to conduct analysis on most effective and cost-efficient method or methods for candidates to provide voters' pamphlet statements in special district elections.

Requires secretary to submit report to Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Α	BILL	FOR	AN	ACT

- Relating to voters' pamphlet statements in special district elections; and declaring an emergency.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. (1) The Secretary of State shall conduct an analysis and determine the most effective and cost-efficient method or methods for candidates to provide voters' pamphlet statements in special district elections.
  - (2) The secretary shall submit a report on the analysis described in subsection (1) of this section to the interim legislative committees on rules no later than September 15, 2015.
  - SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
