House Bill 3336

Sponsored by Representative HERNANDEZ; Representatives CLEM, GREENLICK, MCLAIN, POWER, Senators FAGAN, FREDERICK

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Provides that use of certain name other than name displayed on government-issued identification document does not constitute crime of giving false information to a peace officer in connection with a citation or warrant.

- 2 Relating to giving false information to a peace officer; amending ORS 162.385 and 807.620.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 162.385 is amended to read:
- 5 162.385. (1) A person commits the crime of giving false information to a peace officer in con-
- 6 nection with a citation or warrant if the person knowingly uses or gives a false or fictitious name,
- 7 address or date of birth to any peace officer when:
- 8 (a) The peace officer is issuing or serving the person a citation under authority of ORS 133.055 9 to 133.076 or ORS chapter 153; or
 - (b) There is an outstanding warrant for the person's arrest.
- 11 (2) Giving false information to a peace officer in connection with a citation or warrant is a Class 12 A misdemeanor.

- (a) "False or fictitious name" does not include a preferred name.
- 15 (b) "Preferred name" means a name other than the name displayed on a person's 16 government-issued identification document that is used regularly by the person:
 - (A) As a form of gender expression;
 - (B) To avoid a risk to personal safety;
 - (C) For a professional or official purpose; or
 - (D) As a nickname or anglicized form of the name displayed on the person's government-issued identification document.
 - **SECTION 2.** ORS 807.620 is amended to read:
 - 807.620. (1) A person commits the offense of giving false information to a police officer if the person knowingly uses or gives a false or fictitious name, address or date of birth to any police officer who is enforcing motor vehicle laws.
- 26 (2) The offense described in this section, giving false information to a police officer, is a Class 27 A misdemeanor.
 - (3) As used in this section:
 - (a) "False or fictitious name" does not include a preferred name.
 - (b) "Preferred name" means a name other than the name displayed on a person's
