SUMMARY

Digest: The Act gives moneys to an agency for deposit in a new fund related to groups that fight fires in certain rural areas. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.1).

Appropriates moneys out of the General Fund to the State Forestry Department for deposit in

the Rangeland Protection Association Fund.
Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to fire protection; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
5	ated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the
6	General Fund, the amount of \$, for deposit in the Rangeland Protection Association
7	Fund established by section 4, chapter, Oregon Laws 2025 (Enrolled House Bill 3349).
8	SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect
10	on its passage.
