House Bill 3364

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires forensic laboratory to test blood or urine sample within 90 days of receiving sample in prosecution of driving while under influence of intoxicants.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to driving while under the influence of intoxicants.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "forensic laboratory" means a forensic laboratory

established by the Department of State Police under ORS 181A.150 that is accredited by a
national forensic accrediting organization.

7 (2) Within 90 days of receiving a blood or urine sample in a prosecution of driving while

8 under the influence of intoxicants under ORS 813.010, a forensic laboratory shall test a

9 person's blood or urine to determine the alcohol content of the person's blood or urine, or

10 both, and for the purpose of determining the presence of cannabis, psilocybin, a controlled

11 substance or an inhalant in the person.
