AN ACT

Relating to payment of dependent care tax credits in installments; and prescribing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) No later than 90 days after the effective date of this 2017 Act, the Department of Human Services shall submit to the United States Department of Agriculture a request for approval to waive the requirements of 7 U.S.C. 2014(d)(18) in order to exclude monthly distributions of an advance payment of the tax credit available for dependent care under ORS 315.264 from consideration in determining eligibility for Supplemental Nutrition Assistance.

(2) The department shall report the status of the request to the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2018, and annually thereafter until September 15 following the date that the United States Department of Agriculture approves or denies the request for waiver.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 1, 2023.

SECTION 3. This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017 regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
