SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Provides that contract to allow use of property or facilities by nonprofit organization providing services to youths or by certain educational provider may not require individual participant to indemnify property owner for damages not caused by individual participant. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2 Relating to indemnification; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. (1) A contract to allow the use of property or facilities by a nonprofit or-4

ganization providing services to youths or by a public or private elementary or secondary $\mathbf{5}$

school or an education service district may not require an individual participating in the use 6

of the property or facilities to indemnify the owner of the property or facilities for damages 7

not caused by the individual. 8

(2) Any provision in a contract that violates subsection (1) of this section is void. 9

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act applies only to contracts entered into on or after 10

the effective date of this 2015 Act. 11

SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 1213 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage. 14
