

House Bill 3461

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Office of Emergency Management of Oregon Military Department to increase staffing level of office to better coordinate and facilitate private sector and governmental response to, and recovery from, natural and human-caused emergencies.

Appropriates moneys to department to support increased staffing level.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the staffing level of the Office of Emergency Management; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Office of Emergency Management of the Oregon Military Department,**
5 **in order to better fulfill the responsibilities of the office under ORS 401.052, shall create, fill**
6 **and utilize the following employment positions:**

7 (1) **Seven regional support specialists;**

8 (2) **Five disaster grant specialists; and**

9 (3) **Three trainers.**

10 **SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
11 **ated to the Oregon Military Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the**
12 **General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for the purpose of the Office of Emergency Manage-**
13 **ment carrying out the provisions of section 1 of this 2015 Act.**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
16 **July 1, 2015.**
