## AN ACT

Relating to documents recording a death that are in the custody of a county official; creating new provisions; amending ORS 432.355; and declaring an emergency.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

**SECTION 1.** ORS 432.355 is amended to read:

432.355. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a document recording a death filed in conjunction with owning or having a claim or interest in land that is in the custody of a county clerk or county recording officer is open and subject to full disclosure. A county clerk or county recording officer may not record a document [recording] that records a death filed in conjunction with owning or having a claim or interest in land [may not include] if the document originated in this state and includes medical information related to the cause of death.

SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 432.355 by section 1 of this 2014 Act apply to documents that record a death that occurs on or after January 1, 2014.

SECTION 3. This 2014 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2014 Act takes effect on its passage.
