## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Authorizes Department of Land Conservation and Development to approve local governments' plans for urban growth boundary expansion areas that will accommodate affordable housing.]

Extends Department of Land Conservation and Development reporting requirements on affordable housing pilot program through 2024. Requires 2022 report to include specified information regarding expansion of pilot statewide.

Sunsets [affordable housing] pilot program on January 2, [2024] 2028.

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- Relating to expansion of urban growth boundaries to accommodate affordable housing; amending section 9, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016; and repealing sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 9, chapter 52, Oregon Laws 2016, is amended to read:
  - **Sec. 9.** (1) The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall report on the progress of the pilot program, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, to the committees of the Legislative Assembly related to housing and human services:
  - [(1)] (a) At least once during each of [three] eight consecutive regular sessions of the Legislative Assembly, beginning with the 2017 regular session of the Legislative Assembly; and
  - [(2)] (b) At least once following adjournment sine die of the regular sessions of the Legislative Assembly described in [subsection (1) of this section] paragraph (a) of this subsection, but no later than the convening of the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly.
  - (2) The report given during the 2022 regular session of the Legislative Assembly under subsection (1)(a) of this section must include information regarding:
  - (a) A summary and comparison of the experiences reported by the cities participating in the pilot program;
    - (b) An analysis of the potential effects of extending the pilot program statewide;
  - (c) Whether a statewide implementation of the pilot program would significantly improve the availability of housing units;
  - (d) The extent to which criteria for compliance with the pilot program would be prohibitive for other cities if the program were extended statewide; and
  - (e) Suggestions for additions to or subtractions from the criteria for compliance with the program and elements of the program if the pilot program were extended statewide and the
