SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and specified federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from other federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries;

3 and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There is appropriated to the State Department of Geology and Mineral In-6 dustries, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of 7 \$5,986,843 for operations of the department.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 9 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment 10 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-11 eral funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described 12 in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Geology and Mineral In-13 dustries, for the following purposes:

14 (1) Geologic survey...... \$ 2,648,281

15 (2) Mined land reclamation \$ 4,221,055

16 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 17 \$5,927,333 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for 18 payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2021 19 Act, collected or received by the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.

20 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 21 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect 22 July 1, 2021.
