

Enrolled House Bill 5015

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Justice; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:

- (1) Appellate Division \$ 317,395
- (2) Civil Enforcement Division \$ 700,777
- (3) Criminal Justice Division..... \$ 13,685,070
- (4) Crime Victims' Services
Division \$ 7,897,096
- (5) Defense of Criminal
Convictions..... \$ 23,635,069
- (6) Division of Child Support..... \$ 28,060,876
- (7) Debt service and related
costs..... \$ 9,294,608

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Justice, for the following purposes:

- (1) Office of the Attorney
General and administration \$ 36,088,056
- (2) Appellate Division \$ 20,954,182
- (3) Civil Enforcement Division \$ 79,415,670
- (4) Criminal Justice Division..... \$ 14,483,746
- (5) Crime Victims' Services
Division \$ 34,154,612
- (6) General Counsel Division..... \$ 55,198,520
- (7) Trial Division \$ 32,816,489
- (8) Division of Child Support..... \$ 32,359,440

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment

of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Justice for the following purposes:

- (1) Civil Enforcement Division..... \$ 4,446,638
- (2) Criminal Justice Division..... \$ 1,297,481
- (3) Crime Victims' Services
Division \$ 34,465,155
- (4) Division of Child Support..... \$109,730,404

SECTION 4. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.
