House Bill 5019

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Forestry Department for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to department for fire protection expenses.

Authorizes nonlimited expenditures for emergency fire supression. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium

beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following
