8 **“SECTION 5a. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
9 **\$8,240,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for**  
10 **payment of expenses by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from lottery moneys**  
11 **allocated to the Sports Lottery Account.”.**

12 On page 4, delete lines 5 through 12 and insert:
