

House Bill 5031

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Public Safety Standards and Training for debt service.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training;
3 and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and**
6 **Training, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund, the amount of**
7 **\$9,107,640 for debt service.**

8 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
9 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limits for payment**
10 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
11 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Public**
12 **Safety Standards and Training, for the following purposes:**

13 (1) Operations..... \$ 48,965,711

14 (2) Public Safety Memorial Fund ... \$ 291,294

15 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
16 **\$7,583,071 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, as the maximum limit for**
17 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Public**
18 **Safety Standards and Training.**

19 **SECTION 4. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**
21 **July 1, 2021.**
