SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

In memoriam: David B. Frohnmayer, 1940-2015.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 Whereas David Braden "Dave" Frohnmayer was born in Medford, Oregon, in 1940; and 3 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer graduated from Medford High School, where he played cornet in the Black Tornado marching band and was voted Outstanding Senior Man in 1958; and 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Whereas Dave Frohnmayer graduated from Harvard University, and attended Wadham College, 6 Oxford University, on a Rhodes Scholarship; and 7 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer received his law degree from the University of California, Berkeley, 8 School of Law; and 9 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer returned to his native Oregon after marrying his wife, Lynn, to 10 teach law at the University of Oregon; and 11 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer was elected to the Oregon House of Representatives in 1974 and 12served three terms until he was elected Attorney General in 1980; and 13Whereas as Attorney General, Dave Frohnmayer attracted top legal talent and personally ar-14 gued a number of cases before the United States Supreme Court; and Whereas Dave Frohnmayer became the Dean of the University of Oregon School of Law in 1992 15and is credited with saving the school's accreditation; and 16 17 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer was appointed as President of the University of Oregon in 1994; and 18 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer raised more than \$1 billion for the University of Oregon as president from 1994 to 2008; and 19 20 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer instigated the implementation of 19 new degree programs, four en-21dowed professorships, four student housing projects and seven science facilities and paved the way 22for the construction or expansion of the College of Education, Lillis Hall, the Jordan Schnitzer 23 Museum of Art, Miller Theatre Complex and the Many Nations Longhouse; and 24 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer was named as an American Academy of Arts and Sciences Fellow 25in 2002 and appointed to the American Academy of Arts and Sciences Board of Directors in 2013; 26 and 27Whereas with his wife, Lynn, Dave Frohnmayer cofounded the Fanconi Anemia Research Fund, 28raising millions of dollars to fund research to discover a cure for the rare genetic disease that took 29 the lives of two of the couple's five children; and

30 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer was one of the founding directors of the National Marrow Donor

1 Program, also known as "Be the Match"; and

2 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer was a tireless advocate for higher education in Oregon and 3 throughout the nation; and

4 Whereas Dave Frohnmayer had a lifelong love of the arts, science and the rule of law; now, 5 therefore,

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

7 That we, the members of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly, honor and celebrate the life 8 of David Braden "Dave" Frohnmayer and his incredible legacy as a scholar, teacher, mentor and 9 visionary whose humble nature, honorable conduct, intellectual curiosity and inspirational work 10 touched the lives of so many; and be it further
