House Concurrent Resolution 35

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Declares it is policy of State of Oregon to protect refugee and immigrant rights.

2	Whereas the State of Oregon has long benefited from the arrival of refugees from economic,
3	political and religious strife; and
4	Whereas the State of Oregon embraces diversity of background and experience as a foundational
5	element of our state's past, present and future successes; and
6	Whereas the State of Oregon continues to send men and women, including immigrants, into
7	harm's way to defend the ideals of freedom, justice and liberty for all; and
8	Whereas the State of Oregon recognizes the value and virtue of compassion, comity and com-
9	munity; and
10	Whereas the State of Oregon was built on and shall be sustained through the passion, perspec-
11	tive and perseverance of people born in Oregon as well as those who choose to make Oregon a new
12	home; now, therefore,
13	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
14	That we, the members of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly, declare that it is the policy
15	of the State of Oregon to embrace our state's role as a caretaker of democracy, as a defender of the

rights of humankind and as a shelter for all persons seeking safe harbor from oppression, regardless

of gender, race, nationality, religion, sexual orientation or socioeconomic status.
