# A-Engrossed Senate Bill 1562

#### SUMMARY

## Digest: The Act raises the maximum amount of money that can be held in a reserve fund. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.2).

#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; amending ORS 293.148.

#### **3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

### 4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 293.148 is amended to read:

5 293.148. (1) If the moneys in the Oregon Rainy Day Fund established by ORS 293.144 just prior

6 to the time of a transfer scheduled under ORS 293.144 (3) or 293.146 equal at least [7-1/2] 12.5 per-

7 cent of the amount of General Fund revenues collected during the prior biennium, moneys that

8 would otherwise be transferred to the Oregon Rainy Day Fund shall be deposited in the General9 Fund.

10 (2) If the moneys in the Oregon Rainy Day Fund just prior to the time of a transfer scheduled 11 under ORS 293.144 (3) or 293.146 do not equal at least [7-1/2] **12.5** percent of the amount of General 12 Fund revenues collected during the prior biennium, the transfer to the Oregon Rainy Day Fund shall 13 be made regardless of whether that transfer increases the amount in the Oregon Rainy Day Fund 14 to at least [7-1/2] **12.5** percent of the amount of General Fund revenues collected during the prior 15 biennium.
