3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Revenue shall study issues related to providing a
5	preferential tax rate for benefit companies in this state.
6	(2) The department shall provide the Legislative Assembly with the results of the
7	department's study not later than December 31, 2018.
