SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act makes an electric company report each year on the steps taken or being taken to be part of an energy market. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.1).

Requires an investor-owned utility that sells more than two million megawatt hours of electricity in a calendar year to report to the Legislative Assembly the activities, if any, that the investor-owned utility has taken or is taking toward participating in a regional energy market.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to the reporting of the status of a regional energy market.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "investor-owned utility" means a public utility, as defined in ORS 757.005, that provides electric power and is regulated by the Public Utility Commission under ORS chapter 757.
 - (2) An investor-owned utility that sells more than two million megawatt hours of electricity in a calendar year shall submit a report, as described in subsection (3) of this section, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to the Legislative Assembly no later than January 15 of the following year.
 - (3) The report required under subsection (2) of this section must inform the Legislative Assembly of any activities, including any plans or preparations, that the investor-owned utility has taken or is taking toward participating in a regional energy market.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2024 Act applies to calendar years beginning on or after January 1, 2024.

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
