

Senate Bill 160

Sponsored by Senator WHITSETT, Representative WHITSETT (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires confirmation by Legislative Assembly of new designation of scenic waterway for designation to become effective.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to legislative confirmation of scenic waterway designations; amending ORS 390.865.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 390.865 is amended to read:

390.865. The designation of a river or segment of a river and related adjacent land, pursuant to ORS 390.855, shall not become effective **except upon confirmation by joint resolution of the Legislative Assembly that is in session at the time the designation is made or during the next regular session of the Legislative Assembly. Any designation or part of the designation that is not confirmed by the Legislative Assembly shall not become effective.** [*until the day following the adjournment sine die of the regular session of the Legislative Assembly next following the date of the designation or that was in session when the designation was made. The Legislative Assembly by joint resolution may disapprove any such designation or a part thereof, and in that event the designation, or part thereof so disapproved, shall not become effective.*]

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
