Senate Bill 22

Sponsored by Senator FINDLEY (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Water Resources Commission to develop and adopt by rule regional water management pilot program that allows regions to establish voluntary water management. Sunsets pilot program on January 2, 2030.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to a regional water management pilot program. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. (1) The Water Resources Commission shall develop and adopt by rule a re-4

gional water management pilot program that allows regions to establish voluntary water $\mathbf{5}$ 6 management.

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7 (2) Rules adopted by the commission to implement the program must:

(a) Establish mechanisms for mitigation and exchange to codify water user agreements 8 among water users in the same region; 9

(b) Create a framework that regions may voluntarily adopt to allow for protection of 10 exchanged water and recognition of exchanged water as an in-stream mitigation credit to the 11 12 receiving water user;

(c) Allow persons holding valid water rights or water right certificates to apply for per-13mission to use stored, surface or ground water from another source in the same region in 14 exchange for supplying replacement water in equal amounts to satisfy prior appropriations 15 16 from the other sources;

17(d) Allow persons to apply for an exchange among any combination of surface, storage 18 or ground water rights; and

(e) Require that applications for exchange be accompanied by maps, documentation and 19 20 other information necessary to ensure that requested exchanges do not cause injury to other 21water rights or enlarge water rights.

22SECTION 2. The Water Resources Commission shall prepare and submit a report in the 23manner provided in ORS 192.245 on the implementation of the regional water management pilot program, that may include recommendations for legislation, to a committee or interim 24committee of the Legislative Assembly related to water: 25

- 26 (1) On or before September 15, 2025; and
- (2) On or before September 15, 2029. 27
- SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2030. 28
